	<p><u>Maths</u> Practice counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.</p>	<p><u>Topic</u> Make a board game based on a Traditional Tale e.g. Red Riding Hood, 3 Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk etc</p>	<p><u>English</u> Draw a story map of "Goldilocks and the Three Bears" and use it to retell the story.</p>
	<p><u>Topic</u> Share a story about night time</p>	<p><u>English</u></p>	<p><u>Maths</u> Find examples of the following shapes in your house/garden: <i>cylinder, sphere, cube, cuboid.</i></p>
