Reading Record books and Reading books are brought to school every day.

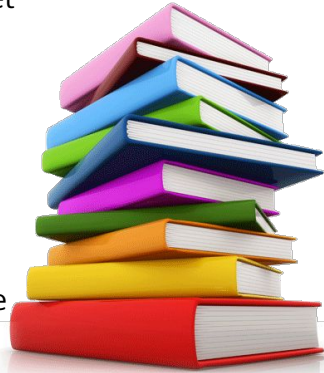


Your child continues to read regularly at home and practises their spellings, using the sheet provided. Spelling Tests are on Fridays.

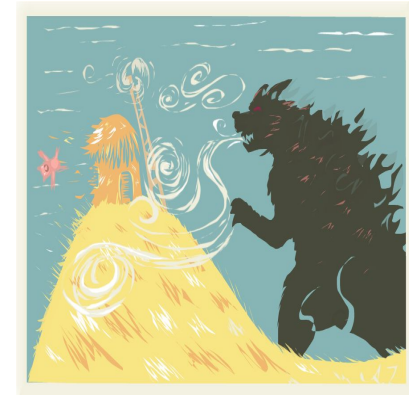
Year Two Summer Term 2019

Twisted Tales

Do we really need to be afraid of the Big Bad wolf?



To launch our topic we have been reading a range of traditional tales with a twist. The children have loved the story of The Three Little Wolves and The Big Bad Pig and The Stinky Cheese Man. They will be planning and writing their own Twisted Tales which they will present to the Year One children at the end of the topic.



English

Our Literacy learning continues to focus on spelling, punctuation and grammar. The children will be writing their own 'Twisted Tale' based on The Three Little Pigs. As a school we have been focussing on handwriting and presentation and the children will be making their own books to showcase these skills. They will also be sharing and writing poetry linked to the work of Michael Rosen.



Maths

We continue to approach our Maths learning using the Singapore Maths programme. The children will be developing their understanding of measures including length, mass and capacity. They will continue to expand their knowledge of the four operations of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. They will also be collecting data and producing graphs and charts linked to our Science learning.

RE

This term we are learning about the Christian faith and in particular, The Gospel.

Art and Design

This term the children will be designing and making story characters which move. They will explore a range of joining techniques and they will use a variety of finishing materials to add effect.

P.E.

In our P.E. sessions this term the children will receive coaching from Mr Kent. They will be developing Tennis skills as well as taking part in our new Real PE programme which encourages the development of a range of movement skills.

Science

In our Science sessions this half term the children will be investigating the conditions needed for plants to grow. They will examine a variety of seeds and beans and they will identify their features by dissecting them.

They will also be using the woodland area to identify different micro-habitats inhabited by a variety of mini beasts.



Computing

The children will be using a variety of websites to further their knowledge of insects and micro habitats. They will take photos and edit their pictures as well as ask Yes and No questions to decide which group a bug belongs to.
