



	<p>Maths</p> <p>Practise telling the time to o'clock and half past.</p>	<p>Topic</p> <p>Make a board game based on a Traditional Tale e.g. Red Riding Hood, 3 Little Pigs, Jack and the Beanstalk etc</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Draw a story map of "Goldilocks and the Three Bears" and use it to retell the story.</p>
	<p>Topic</p> <p>Draw pictures and/or write sentences to show examples of things that you have done which have shown FORGIVENESS.</p>	<p>English</p> <p>Practise reading and spelling the following words correctly: <i>where, there, here, your, were</i></p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Use non standard units (eg paper clips, penny coins, straws) to measure the length of a variety of objects around your home eg TV, pen, plate, book.</p>
