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| Read a story with a relative. | Have a Teddy bears picnic. | Play I-Spy with my coloured eye. | Build a den using household items eg bed sheets, Chairs, Boxes |
| Sing a Nursery Rhyme with a relative. | Help make lunch - can you spread some butter/ spread on your bread? | Draw a picture of your family using pens, crayons or paints. | Go on a listening walk - What can you hear? |
| Play a game with a relative. | Go on a number hunt around the house. Can you record the numbers you find? | What day is it today? Sing the days of the week song with a relative and work out which day it is. Use the language of Yesterday, Tomorrow, before and after. | Design a pair of pants for Pantosaurus - Watch the Pantosaurus video on NSPCC website. |
| Count objects around your house - How many Chairs? How many Teddies? How many cars? How many beds? Can you record your findings? | Go on a shape hunt around the house. Can you draw the shapes you find? | How many rhyming words can you find around the house eg. Sock, Clock | Blending- Select some objects from around the house and place on the table. By segmenting the word can your child blend the sounds to select the correct object? Eg. C-u-p, p-e-n, s-o-ck, h-a-t |
