We will have **two** afternoons this term to share Home Learning. **Thursday 13th February** and **Friday 28th February**.

Please bring in homework **on these two days only** and we will have a gallery across the three classes.

Tricky

- Research the Great Fire of Dorchester
- Write a fact file about the Great Fire of London - or Dorchester!.
- Create a model of a famous London landmark
- Write an adventure story about someone caught up in the Great Fire.
- Follow a recipe to bake something for a Pudding Lane bakery. Use scales to measure out the ingredients.
- Create Maths word problems linked to our topic.

Moderate

- Make a model of a Great Fire house.
- Write a diary entry as if you were living through the Great Fire - just like Samuel Pepys!
- Draw a detailed pencil drawing of London
- Create a fire safety poster.
- Create a game linked to our topic.
- Sew a salamander or another fire reptile.

Easy

- Create a model relating to the topic out of junk modelling lego / play dough / clay etc
- Visit London and take some photos.
- Write instructions for making a campfire.
- Write a postcard describing a London visit.
- Painting / collage relating to the topic
- Learn a campfire song.

Year 2 Additional Home Learning: March 2020

These activities are in addition to our Fire! Fire! Topic web, as we are still completing this work.

Tricky

- Research a famous scientist
- Write a fact file about the Coronavirus
- Create a model of a famous landmarks around the world
- Write an adventure story
- Follow a recipe to bake something new - use scales to measure out the ingredients
- Create Maths word problems linked to our topic
- Learn a new skill - perhaps sewing, knitting - the possibilities are endless!

Moderate

- Make an Easter /Spring model
- Retell the story of Easter
- Draw a detailed pencil drawing of Spring
- Create a poster to show how to keep germs away
- Create a game linked to some of our learning
- Paint a picture in the style of Lowry or Turner

Easy

- Read everyday
- Practise Times Tables Rockstars and spellings
- Write different sentence types about Easter or another topic (statements, commands, questions and exclamations)
- Write a postcard to a neighbour
- Painting / collage relating to the topic
- Ask someone to write some sentences and see if you can correct their mistakes!
