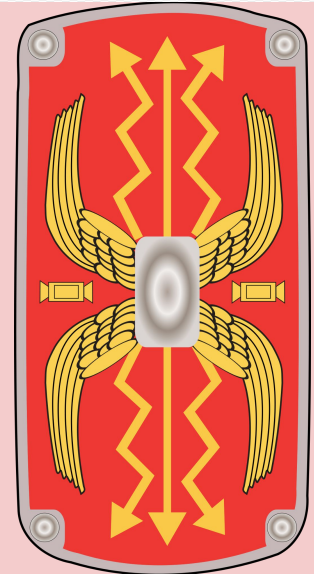
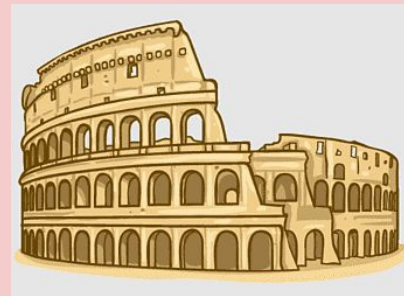

What did the Romans ever do for us?



Year 3 Summer 2023

English

This half term as writers, we will be finding out about the fascinating food eaten in the Roman times and then writing our own Rotten Roman recipes. This will build on the work we did on instruction writing in the Autumn term.

We will be also writing a newspaper entry of the Roman invasion of Britain and a biography of Boudicca. Our Class books is The Abominables by Eva Ibbotson.

We will also be reading History Hackers - The Roman Rescue.

Science- As scientists, this half term we will be learning what plants need to survive and creating an investigation to see which elements are most important for a plant. The children will be studying and comparing the life cycle of plants and animals.

DT

As designers, we will explore the Roman waterway system and design, make and evaluate our own Roman aqueducts.

RE - As Theologians, the children will be looking at the meaning of a religious pilgrimage and building on their knowledge and understanding of Hindu beliefs and practises to discover the importance of the River Ganges in Hinduism.

Personal Development -

Our Jigsaw theme is Relationships. The children will use the Jigsaw approach to explore the areas friendship including online friends.

Our protected characteristic this half term is Race and our favourite 5 books will reflect this.

Art

As artists, the children will be exploring Roman sculpture and the art of mosaics. They will design and make their own clay tile and mosaic piece.

Music- As musician, we will be learning to play different Samba instruments and be part of a Samba band, lead by a teacher from the Dorset musicianship service.

French As linguists, we will be exploring how to communicate our food preferences.

ICT Within our ICT sessions we will be researching and creating a page about Roman life on Google Slides. We will be making choices about fonts, colours and positions of text as well as adding pictures.

Maths

As Mathematicians, we will begin the half- term by finding out what a fraction is and how we can calculate fractions of shapes and numbers. We will then move on to comparing and ordering unit fractions and adding and subtracting unit fractions.

Later on in the half term, we will explore different types quadrilaterals and triangles as part of geometry. As a support to Maths Fluency, it is important for your child to have quick recall of their multiplication tables 2,5,10, 3,4,6 and 8 before the end of Year 3 so we will continue to do a times table Maths session each week.

PE - The children will be focussing on athletics with Mr Treble where they will gain a variety of athletic skills in events including jumping, running and throwing. In indoor PE, they will be exploring synchronized dance routines ready for their visit the Dance, Dance, Dance at Poole lighthouse Theatre.

SUMMER 1ST HOME LEARNING

English

Reading is an essential part of your child's education. Each week, if your child reads 3 or more times at home and the reading record is signed by an adult, they can earn a bead for their keyring.

Spellings - lists will be posted on Google Classroom.

Maths:

Maths fluency is important as it is part of your child's everyday life now and in the future. Practise 2,5,10,3,4, 6,,8 times tables daily for 20 minutes using TT Rockstars.

Your child will have login details for TT Rockstars in their reading records.
