Maths

In maths we will continue to consolidate our number bonds but now we will be looking at number bonds to 10.
We will be looking at 2d and 3d shapes and looking at their properties. .

Knowledge and understanding of the world

The children will be learning about 'under the sea' and how we all play a part in looking after our environment. They will learn about sea pollution and the effect that this can have and what we can do to try and stop it.

We will also be looking at pirates. What a pirate is and what they did and some famous pirates from the past.
